Inaugural Session of the 10th Annual General Meeting of FANS

The inaugural session of the 10th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of Rashtriya Suraksha Jagran Manch (FANS) commenced with great enthusiasm and a strong spirit of nationalism on the evening of July 11, 2025. Held at the tranquil Sahib Farms and Resort in Bakhtawarpur, Delhi, the event marked a pivotal moment in the organisation's journey, uniting delegates, members, and esteemed guests from various parts of the country.

The proceedings began with registration at 3:00 PM, followed by high tea at 5:00 PM, setting a warm and welcoming tone for the days ahead.

The program commenced at 6:00 PM with the traditional lighting of the ceremonial lamp, symbolizing knowledge, unity, and progress. The proceedings were elegantly and thoughtfully anchored by Dr. Seema Singh Ji, who also delivered the welcome address, expressing heartfelt gratitude to the dignitaries and members present.

Key Dignitaries and Their Addresses:

- **Manniye Dr. Indresh Kumar Ji, Mukhya Margdarshak, Rashtriya Suraksha Jagran Manch (FANS)**

The Chief Guest, Dr. Indresh Kumar Ji, delivered a stirring and insightful keynote address. He congratulated the organization on completing ten impactful years and emphasized that national security is a collective duty-not solely the responsibility of the armed forces. He highlighted that the true pillars of security lie in cultural strength, ideological clarity, and national unity.

“This AGM is a symbol of FANS’ stability and growth. It is also a platform to shape its future direction,” he said.

He also applauded the organization's efforts to instill values of patriotism, service, and goodwill in India's youth.

➤ **Sardar Jasbir Singh Ji (Working National President, FANS & Former Chairman, Rajasthan Minorities Commission)**

Sardar Jasbir Singh Ji welcomed all attendees and reflected on FANS' inspiring 10-year journey. He emphasized the need for the organization to expand its role in addressing national security challenges, urging members to consider how FANS can contribute meaningfully to security policy and awareness.

He referenced to current global conflicts—such as the Russia-Ukraine war and Israel-Iran tensions—to highlight

the importance of civil society in national preparedness. He praised Prime Minister Modi's leadership, noting

how India is leading from power to peace on the world stage.

Looking ahead, he affirmed that FANS will play a vital role in achieving the vision of India@2047, pledging that Rashtriya Suraksha Jagran Manch (RSJM) will give its all toward realizing that national dream.

“India today is not just a passive observer but an active contributor to global peace and balance,” he noted, “and FANS must align itself with this vision-contributing awareness, ideas, and action.”

➤ **Shri Madhurendra Kumar Ji (Senior Editor, News Nation)**

Shri Madhurendra Kumar Ji delivered a focused and impactful address, highlighting the core principles that have guided FANS-Transparency, Service, and Participation. He emphasized the need for self-evaluation and encouraged the youth to actively contribute to shaping a secure and united India.

He outlined two major security concerns: internal and external, with particular emphasis on internal security threats such as Rohingya infiltration, illegal migration from Bangladesh, and the political conditions in West Bengal and Bihar. He asserted that post-2014; India has remained free from major terrorist attacks due to stronger internal vigilance.

He underlined the importance of policies like CAA and NRC for safeguarding national unity and preventing internal fragmentation, drawing parallels with the territorial crises in Ukraine. Citing examples of Ukraine and Israel, he stressed that nationalistic spirit, patriotism, and a strong defence mindset-starting from schools- are crucial for internal security, and that India must adopt similar models.

He firmly stated that India must never be allowed to break into pieces geographically or ideologically.

➤ **Shri Vijay Kranti Ji (Thinker, Writer & Chairman, Himalayan Asia Studies and Engagement)**

Shri Vijay Kranti Ji delivered a compelling and thought-provoking address on India's strategic rise and its position in the Himalayan and Asian geopolitical landscape. He emphasized that public awareness and civil participation form the foundation of national security.

“Awareness is the first line of defense. When citizens are informed, the nation is empowered,” he stated.

He reflected on how, over the past 10 to 11 years, India has transformed from a position of hesitation to one of confidence and strategic clarity. The long-standing inferiority complex, he noted, has ended. Today, India is more assertive and self-reliant-militarily, economically, and diplomatically.

He praised the bold infrastructure developments in Ladakh and border areas, previously avoided out of fear of China's expansionist policies. He lauded the Modi government for these achievements and highlighted the bravery of Indian soldiers during the Galwan clash, calling it a proud moment in India's security history.

Shri Kranti also praised Operation Sindoor, a strategic move against Pakistan, and spoke of India's growing diplomatic maturity, saying the country has now identified its real friends and adversaries. He applauded the current leadership for prioritizing India's national interest above external pressures.

"This government thinks of Bharat first. It's no longer about pleasing others—it's about protecting and promoting our own interests," he said.

In a balanced and inclusive tone, he also emphasized that not every Muslim is anti-national, and many stand with the nation under the spirit of "Bharat First." He praised those who put the country above all and contribute to India's unity and security.

He concluded by urging for a nationalistic mindset, strong neighborhood engagement, and sustained awareness as key tools for a secure and sovereign India.

➤ **Maj. Gen. Sauresh Bhattacharya Ji, President, Delhi Chapter (FANS)- Special Guest**

Maj. Gen. Bhattacharya Ji, the host of the AGM and President of the Delhi Chapter, expressed his pride in organizing the 10th AGM in Delhi.

"The security of the nation encompasses more than just defense forces- it extends into civil society, and organizations like FANS are playing a vital role," he said.

He emphasized the importance of a vigilant and informed citizenry in upholding the integrity and sovereignty of the nation.

➤ **Dr. Indresh Kumar Ji (Mukhya Margdarshak, Rashtriya Suraksha Jagran Manch – FANS) Chief Guest**

Dr. Indresh Kumar Ji, the Chief Guest, delivered a powerful and visionary keynote address, congratulating FANS on its ten-year journey of impactful work in promoting national security awareness. He reaffirmed that national security is a shared responsibility, extending beyond the armed forces to every citizen. He emphasized that the true foundation of a secure nation lies in cultural strength, ideological clarity, and national unity.

"This AGM is a symbol of FANS' stability and growth. It is also a platform to shape its future direction," he said. He praised FANS for instilling patriotism, service, and social harmony among India's youth and called on the organization to continue playing a strong role in public awareness through social media and grassroots engagement.

Dr. Kumar invoked a powerful message of hope and resilience:

"Khoya jan bhi aayega, khoyi zameen bhi aayegi"

(A reminder that what are lost-whether lives or land- can be regained.)

He addressed critical concerns around China's aggressive border posture, stating that while the China border acts like a wall, India's resolve and sovereignty remain unshaken despite encroachments. He strongly rejected divisions based on religion, caste, language, or forced conversion, stating that such acts are neither ethical nor constitutional.

Speaking on global issues like the Israel-Iran conflict, he urged Indians to stay focused on India's priorities, not to act as agents of any foreign ideology. He warned against the misuse of Islamic brotherhood as a cover for violence, and he highlighted the internal ethnic and religious strife in Pakistan, where attacks on temples, mosques, Churches, and Gurdwaras are a harsh reality.

"Today's India is not the India of the past. This is new India-strong, aware, and assertive," he declared. He concluded by saying that Bharat is becoming a role model for the world, not through dominance but through its universal, inclusive ideas-ideas that, in his words, "will never fade."

Day Two-First Session Highlights (12-07-2025)

The second day of the 10th Annual National General Assembly of Rashtriya Suraksha Jagran Manch (RSJM) commenced with the first session at 10:00 AM, moderated by Shri Vikramaditya Singh Ji.

This session was dedicated to presenting the Annual Progress Reports by RSJM units from across the country. The organization currently operates through seven key zones, under which 45 active chapters function nationwide.

Representatives from each of these chapters provided a comprehensive account of their work and achievements over the past year. These reports highlighted grassroots outreach, campaign execution, challenges faced, and collaborative efforts among various units.

The session also fostered inter-unit visibility and familiarity, strengthening internal coordination and aligning future strategies with RSJM's national objectives.

Day 2- Second Session

➤ **Speaker: Major General Suresh Bhattacharya Ji (President, Delhi Chapter- FANS)**

In the third session, Major General Suresh Bhattacharya Ji, President of the Delhi Chapter, spoke on the topic "India's Emerging Leadership Role in Regional Stability."

He stated that India is now emerging not only as a leader in Asia but also globally- guiding the world toward

stability, peace, and balance. This evolving role is not just about military or economic power, but also reflects

moral and cultural leadership.

In his insightful analysis, he highlighted how India's policy, intent, and leadership have earned it a reliable and responsible image even during times of regional instability. He contrasted this with Pakistan, which he said has become a symbol of failure and extremism, while India today represents stable democracy, composed leadership, and global diplomacy.

Major General Bhattacharya also emphasized India's deep-rooted cultural ties across South and Southeast Asia. He referred to ancient connections with countries like Thailand (formerly Siam), Cambodia, and Indonesia, highlighting how these regions reflect India's influence. He discussed the Silk Road and how Chinese scholars once came to India to gain knowledge-underscoring India's rich intellectual tradition.

He further noted that now is the time for India to rethink and reshape its foreign policy and diplomatic strategy, ensuring it aligns with India's own national interests first.

➤ **Maj. Gen. Anuj Mathur Ji, VSM, Topic: "No More Pakistan-From Slogan to Strategic Policy"**

In his thought-provoking second address, Maj. Gen. Anuj Mathur Ji, VSM strongly emphasized that the time has come for India to convert the slogan "No More Pakistan" into a clear and actionable national policy.

He stated that Pakistan has repeatedly challenged India's sovereignty, peace, and citizen safety-whether through proxy wars in Kashmir, drone attacks, or cross-border terrorism and infiltration.

"India must now officially identify Pakistan as a factory of terrorism," he declared.

He further reminded the audience that India's defense strength in 1945 stood at 2.5 million—the largest in the world, but colonial powers, especially Britain, deliberately divided India to weaken its global influence.

Maj. Gen. Mathur appreciated the efforts of the current government in systematically strengthening India's military capabilities, and restoring the nation's strategic, structural, and psychological confidence.

He concluded by underlining the need for a bold and uncompromising security doctrine, rooted in national interest, asserting:

“Now is the time for India to act with clarity and strength—not just slogans, but solid policy.”

➤ **Dr. Robin Hisang Topic: “Water Bomb of China: A Silent Threat to India”**

Renowned expert on water geopolitics and international relations, Dr. Robin Hisang, delivered a powerful presentation on the theme of China's aggressive control over Transboundary Rivers, particularly those originating in Tibet.

He warned that China's large-scale water storage and diversion projects are emerging as a “silent but destructive threat” to India and South Asia. These activities are not conventional military moves but represent a new form of pressure through hydrological manipulation.

“The threat is not coming through weapons, but through the manipulation of rivers,” Dr. Hisang said. Dr. Hisang emphasized that such control poses a severe risk to India's national security, environmental stability, and regional peace. He described this policy as a strategic “Water Bomb”, which allows China to control river flows—potentially triggering artificial droughts or floods downstream.

He further highlighted the strategic importance of Arunachal Pradesh, stating that this region could become a critical frontier in India's water security and national sovereignty. China's frequent disputes over Arunachal, paired with its water diversion tactics, reveal a calculated approach to exert pressure on India from both territorial and environmental fronts.

➤ **India's Borders Are Now Stronger Than Ever: Sanjay Kundu**

Former Director General of Police, Himachal Pradesh, Shri Sanjay Kundu, stated that India has undergone significant changes, especially in its border strategy. He emphasized that there has been a major positive shift in how India approaches its border regions, compared to earlier times.

Today, India is not only securing its borders but also extending infrastructure—such as roads and connectivity—right up to the last village, which he termed as a very important development.

Sharing his personal experiences, he highlighted how strategic improvements have consistently been made in the border areas. He also pointed out that had these strategic changes not occurred in time, India might have faced greater challenges and losses from China and Pakistan. This shift reflects a new India—stronger, more prepared, and focused on safeguarding its territorial integrity.

➤ **Prof. Dr. Mehtab Alam Rizvi, Registrar of Jamia Millia Islamia**, delivered his address on the theme Himalaya-Hind Mahasagar Rashtira Samuh (HHRS). He emphasized that the Himalayas are not merely a geographical boundary but the cultural soul of India. He highlighted that the cultural security of border regions, the dignity of local life, and national sovereignty are deeply interconnected. He strongly asserted that ensuring the protection of citizens living in the Himalayan regions is India's foremost national responsibility. Prof. Rizvi expressed concern over China's activities along India's northern borders, including infrastructure development, construction of artificial villages, and renaming of places, calling them direct threats not only to regional security but also to the human rights of local populations.

Importantly, he underscored the strategic relevance of the "Himalaya-Hind Mahasagar Rashtra Samuh (HHRs)" a vision that integrates the Himalayan frontiers with the Indian Ocean as part of a larger national and regional security framework. According to him, this concept reflects India's responsibility to lead in maintaining security, cultural unity, and geopolitical balance across Asia. India must actively engage in safeguarding this integrated region, which is vital to its long-term sovereignty and stability.

The second session on July 12, 2025, concluded with a thoughtful **Vote of Thanks delivered by Shri Jasbir Singh Ji**, who appreciated the insightful contributions made by all the speakers. In his remarks, he emphasized that now is the time for India to strategically de-couple from Pakistan, moving beyond slogans to policy-level decisions.

He also highlighted that the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) is now taking deeper and more direct interest in India's national security and foreign affairs. Shri Jasbir Singh stressed that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has made national borders a strategic priority—ensuring that every ministry regularly visits border areas. This initiative, he noted, is essential not only for resolving security and strategic concerns but also for ensuring that border communities are actively engaged and not left isolated from mainstream national policy.

The third session of the 10th Annual National General Assembly of the Rashtriya Suraksha Jagran Manch (RSJM) was held on the evening of 12 July 2025 and focused on establishing a comprehensive roadmap for the upcoming year. Moderated by Shri Vikramaditya Ji, the session featured key strategic deliberations aimed at strengthening the organization's national impact and outreach. The stage was honoured by the presence of respected dignitaries- Shri Mananiya Indresh Kumar Ji, Dr. Varnika Sharma Ji, and Shri Jasbir Singh Ji- whose vision and experience helped frame the direction of the discourse.

The session began with a thorough review of ongoing initiatives and transitioned into forward-looking planning. Regional representatives from across the country shared proposals and strategies to enhance RSJM's visibility and effectiveness at the grassroots level. A strong consensus emerged to intensify the nationwide membership drive, emphasizing greater engagement with youth and local communities.

Proposed campaigns for the upcoming months include:

- “No More Pakistan”- a powerful campaign to underscore the need for a definitive policy shift in India's engagement with Pakistan, especially in light of continued cross-border threats.
- “Akhand Bharat Sankalp”- promoting the vision of a culturally and historically unified India.
- “Drug-Free India”-aimed at raising public awareness and community action against substance abuse
- “Cyber Crime Awareness”-focusing on educating the public about digital safety and responsible online behaviour.

- These campaigns are scheduled for key cities and regions such as Jammu & Kashmir, Amritsar, Pathankot, Kolkata, and Kanpur, reflecting a strategically targeted approach to national awareness and mobilization.
- A detailed review of the ongoing membership campaign was also presented. Representatives from Central, Eastern, Northern, Southern, and North-Eastern zones reported growing participation and enthusiasm, especially from the youth sector. There was unanimous agreement to scale up impactful campaigns such as:
- “Hind Mahasagar Se Himalaya”-reinforcing India’s civilizational and strategic links to the Himalayan region.
- “Akhand Bharat Sankalp”
- “Nari Shakti Jagran Abhiyan”-highlighting women’s leadership and empowerment in national discourse.

The day concluded with a grand cultural evening, celebrating India’s rich heritage and patriotic spirit- marking a vibrant and reflective close to the second day of proceedings.

Day Three: First session followed by concluding session

The final day of the 10th Annual National General Assembly of Rashtriya Suraksha Jagran Manch (RSJM) began with an insightful and action-oriented session, moderated by Shri Vikramaditya Singh Ji. The session focused on consolidating the discussions and key outcomes of the previous two days while setting the tone for long-term strategic direction.

The second session of the day focused on a comprehensive review of the national membership drive. Units from Central, Eastern, Northern, Southern, and North-Eastern India reported a notable surge in participation, especially highlighting the growing enthusiasm among the youth. In his moderation, Shri Vikramaditya Singh Ji emphasized the importance of ideological clarity, disciplined organizational structure, and a visionary roadmap. He encouraged all chapters to maintain

- A nationwide "Tiranga Yatra" (Flag March) will also be organized, where the national flag will be ceremoniously hoisted across diverse regions as a collective reaffirmation of patriotism.

He further underlined the nature of future global conflicts by saying:
